VHA organized following activities

1) Environment Awareness Programme

VHA has undertaken environment awareness programme at Sajiwali Shahapur on the Environment Day. The programme was focused on tree plantation. A rally and camp was also arranged on environment awareness and tree plantation, with local people and school children. The VHA mobilized a large number of people who planted 200 trees in village.

2) Programmes for Women

VHA has also taken programmes for women. The VHA organized Mahila Garmpanchyat Member training camp at village Sajiwali. There were 35 women participated in this seminar. The main aim of this seminar is to motivate them for cottage industry, handicraft. It will help them to increase standard of living.

3) Informal Training Camp

We conducted training camp at Village Sajiwali, Shahapur, District Thane, for people and farmers of surrounding villages of Shahapur. Large numbers of people was participated in training camp. Representatives of organization are addressing about organic farming and how to do it? Shown some video clip, Slide show. And also advised them on organic farming methods. Organization help an awareness camp for farmers on organic farming in which vital information was given to them about the importance of organic farming for better agriculture production with minimum expenses.

4) Vocational Training Programme for School Children.

VHA had conducted vocational training programme for school children at village Sajiwali, Shahapur. Under this vocational training programme, the NGO is imparting training to school children ancient agriculture methods, Agnihotra- Homa Therapy, Nursery plantation and other handicrafts items. 25 school children & local people has taken part this vocational training programme.

5) Seminar on Watershed Management

The NGO arranged Seminar on Watershed Management in surrounding villages of Shahapur Taluka for creating awareness on preservation of water resources. It is helpful to farmer, which vital information was given to them about watershed management. The credit of its success also goes to its dedicated and committed team of representatives and volunteers, which despite all difficulties and problems continued to work for people's welfare.

6) Seed Production Programme

This is the most major programme for poor & needy farmers. VHA was arranged " Seed Production Programme " in 15 villages. In this programme, NGO is distributed " Rice Seed " to farmers which is unable to purchase quality seeds from market. NGO was given " Rice Seed " free of cost basis and also given buyback guarantee of their produce with more than extra rate of market.
